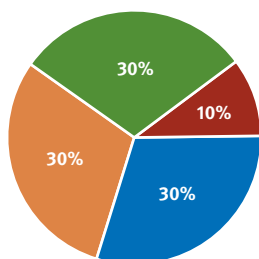

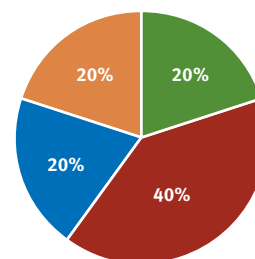
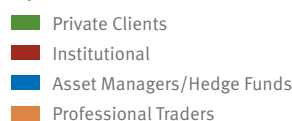

By Market[†]

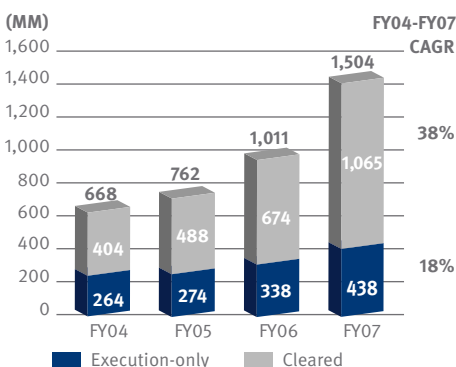


By Customer[†]



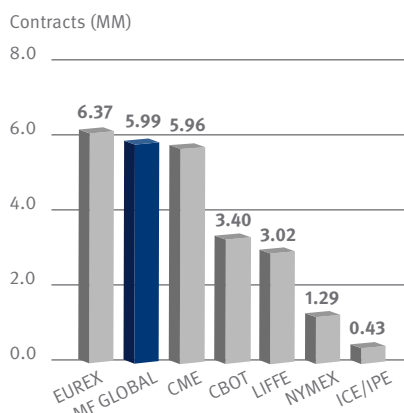
Consistent Volume Growth
